GETTING COMFORTABLE

HOUSE GUIDE

Below are a few helpful tips and instructions on how to make your stay more comfortable and enjoyable!



HOUSE ACCESS

You were provided house access codes upon check-in. These will be your codes for the week. Upon check-out, the codes will expire and you will no longer be able to access the home.



TV&INTERNET

We have provided a robust cable package. Streaming services are also included through Roku and Netflix. High-speed internet is also provided.



LAUNDRY

We have provided detergent to start washing bedding at checkout. We recommend the normal cycle with auto-sensing water level. Please be sure to clean the lint trap to the dryer between each cycle.



TRASH

Trash is collected Monday morning. Please place all trash and recyclables on the curb on Sunday evening for pick up. Discard all trash from inside of the house into the bins provided in the garage. The lids need to be closed, 3 feet apart, and on the curb near the driveway or the truck will not collect. Please bring bins back into garage directly following pick-up.

Below are a few helpful tips and instructions on how to make your stay more comfortable and enjoyable!



THERMOSTAT

Please keep the temperature no lower than 70 degrees during the summer months.

DEFAULT TEMP: 70F



CLEANING

An in-depth disinfecting & cleaning of the home has been done prior to your stay. We have started you with some essential items, including: towels, linens, comforters, hand soap, detergent, dish soap, trash bags, toilet paper, paper towels, etc.



SAFETY

We have provided fire alarms throughout the home for your safety. We have provided a fire extinguisher under the kitchen sink and in the garage. A first aid kit is available in the kitchen pantry if needed.



GRILL

For your comfort, we have provided you with a gas grill.
Please make sure to keep grill away from the home. Ensure grill and propane are turned off when not in use. Please clean grill thoroughly after each use.

POOL SAFETY

Please obey pool rules for your safety. We have also provided door alarms for each door leading to the pool for increased child safety measures. To turn the alarms on/off, move the switch to the ALARM position to activate.

DOOR CLOSURES

Please be sure to close doors after entering and exiting the home. We also encourage our guests to use their personalized code to lock up the home when out and about.

AMENITIES

For your comfort, we have provided additional items for your use while at the home. Please feel free to use the beach cart, beach chairs, umbrella, pool toys, and pack and play as needed. Outdoor items are located in the garage and pack and play is in the closet of the bunk bed room. We ask that you leave these items in the manner you found them.

WI-FI RESET

If you are having trouble connecting to the internet, please try resetting modem/router (under living room TV) by powering off. Power back on, wait a few minutes, and if working the light on top of the modem/router should be white. EMPTY TRASH

COLLECT & TAKE OUT

Please collect all trash that was not previously taken with garbage pick-up and place in garbage cans.





STRIP LINENS

COLLECT & WASH

Please collect all linens that have been used including sheets, bath towels, beach towels, etc. and start a wash cycle for them. Please separate based on colors and whites.





LIGHTS & FANS

TURN OFF

Please turn off all lights and fans throughout the house.

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CLEAN UP
